#### GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

Transfer students are assumed to have completed an Associates of Arts Degree from a Florida Public Institution or satisfied completed 60 credits and the University Core Curriculum Requirements.

In addition, the following courses are required of incoming transfer students:

Global Learning Requirement for Transfers: Transfers entering FIU Fall 2011 or later are required to take two Global Learning courses.

Those who meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-Two Global Learning Discipline Specific Courses (One of the two may be a Global Learning Foundation Course

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chosen in consultation with your advisor)

Those who do not meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

- One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum)
- One Global Learning Discipline Specific Course

Steven J. Green School of International and Public Affairs: Selected Requirements

Foreign Language Requirement: Students must demonstrate competency in a foreign language or in American Sign Language at the level of the second semester of a college language sequence. You may be able to satisfy this requirement with AP, CLEP Exam, or other credit. Contact your advisor.

Grades: Students must earn a grade of "C" or higher in all courses required for the major. A grade of "C-" or lower is not acceptable in any required course.

Steven J. Green School of International and Public Affairs: BS in Crime Science Specific Requirements

Pre-Requisites for Major (will need to be completed if not transferred):

- Should satisfy Foreign Language requirement before transferring.
- STA 2023 Statistics for Business and Economics (pre-requisite: high school algebra)
- BSC 2010 General Biology I (pre-requisite OR co-requisite with BSC 2010L)
- BSC 2010L General Biology I Lab
- CHM 1020 Chemistry and Society (pre-requisite OR co-requisite with CHM 1020L)
- CHM 1020L Chemistry and Society Lab

1. Complete 40 units of Crime Science Core required course work (Check PDA for eligible courses)
2. Complete 5 credit hours of 3000 or 4000 level courses and 9 credit hours outside the Criminology and Criminal Justice Department. Students are strongly encouraged to complete an internship to gain practical experience in the field (CCJ 4940).
