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General Requirements

Prerequisites:

The program assumes the transfer student is entering with an Associate of Arts degree which satisfies the following: Gordon Rule, and Freshman/Sophomore level prerequisite coursework (ARH2050 Art History Survey I and ARH 2051 Art History Survey II, ART1201C 2-D Design and ART 1203C 3-D Design, ART 2300 Beginning Drawing and ART2330C Beginning Figure Drawing, and 6 credits of beginning level ART/PGY Electives.

Critical Indicator is the minimum grade indicated in specific courses to demonstrate proficiency and progress in major. Earning less than the minimum grade is a trigger for a conversation with advisor.

GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

Transfer students are assumed to have completed an Associates of Arts Degree from a Florida Public Institution or satisfied completed 60 credits and the University Core Curriculum Requirements.

In addition, the following courses are required of incoming transfer students:

Global Learning Requirement for Transfers: Transfers entering FIU Fall 2011 or later are required to take two Global Learning courses.

Those who meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-Two Global Learning Discipline Specific Courses (One of the two may be a Global Learning Foundation Course chosen in consultation with your advisor)

Those who do not meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

- -One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum)
- -One Global Learning Discipline Specific Course

College of Communication, Architecture + the Arts: Selected Major Requirements

Grades: Students must earn a grade of "C" or higher in all courses required for the major.

This two-year plan assumes that students will already have satisfied FIU's foreign language requirement. This document only lists SELECTED requirements. See your Panther Degree Audit for all CARTA and major requirements at http://my.fiu.edu.

Academic Standards

To progress into upper-division BFA in Digital Arts: Animation Track courses, students must complete the four lower division foundation courses (12 credits) with a minimum GPA of 2.75 or greater in two attempts or fewer. These courses include:

- ¿ ART 1201C 2D Design
- ¿ ART 1203C 3D Design
- ¿ ART 2300C Beginning Drawing
- ¿ ART 2330C Beginning Figure Drawing

Drops after the add/drop period, which result in a DR grade are considered an attempt in the course and count as an unsuccessful enrollment. Students who do not satisfy this requirement will be advised to change major to other degrees such as BA in Art History or BA in Interdisciplinary Studies.

College of Communication, Architecture + the Arts: BFA in Art Specific Requirements

Students are required to complete 27 units of Studio and Art History Electives. Transfer courses from a 2 year institution may not be used. Only 3000-4000 level transfer courses from four year institutions can be used. Students are also expected to produce a high quality body and complete a written thesis.
