General Requirements

GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

Critical Progress is the minimum grade indicated in specific courses to demonstrate proficiency and progress in major. Earning less than the minimum grade is a trigger for a conversation with advisor.

Transfer students are assumed to have completed an Associates of Arts Degree from a Florida Public Institution or completed 60 credits and the University Core Curriculum Requirements.

In addition, the following courses are required of incoming transfer students:

Global Learning Requirement for Transfers: Transfers entering FIU Fall 2011 or later are required to take two Global Learning courses.

Those who meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-Two Global Learning Discipline Specific Courses (One of the two may be a Global Learning Foundation Course chosen in consultation with your advisor)

Those who do not meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum)

-One Global Learning Discipline Specific Course

Transfer courses may not be used to meet the FIU Global Learning Requirement. For a list of Global learning courses: <http://goglobal.fiu.edu>

College of Communication, Architecture + The Arts: School of Communication + Journalism (SCJ):

Grades: All students must successfully pass MMC3003 (Mass Communication Orientation), and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.85 (this includes all transfer work, in addition to current FIU work).

Writing Proficiency: All students are expected to demonstrate proficiency in writing. Students are required to enroll in a writing course and receive a "C" or higher.

Track courses (9 credits): Students will select 9 credits from a provided list of courses to satisfy this requirement.

Area of Concentration: (12 credits)

Students must select a coherent series of four upper division courses in an area chosen by the student in coordination with their advisor that would indicate a chosen area of focus outside of the SCJ. Students must earn C or higher in courses to be used towards Area of Concentration.

Graduation Policy:

To be eligible for graduation, a student must have a minimum 2.75 GPA in all SCJ courses as well as in the outside courses required by the program.
