#### General Requirements

Those who meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-Two Global Learning Discipline Specific Courses (One of the two may be a Global Learning Foundation Course chosen in consultation with your assigned advisor)

Those who do not meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

- One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum)
- One Global Learning Discipline Specific Course

Postsecondary Civic Literacy (CL): Students must demonstrate understanding of American Civics via completed course work and test credit. Consult with an advisor to determine the best option for satisfying this requirement.

Prerequisite Courses:

There is a minimum GPA of 2.50 required for the program.

### Education Requirements / Teacher Preparation Programs

Field Experience Requirement- additional hours outside of class time - Contact the Office of Clinical Experiences (ZEB 130 / 348-2082) after registration for fingerprint clearance information and school site selection.

Testing -Teacher Preparation Programs require completion of the Florida Teacher Certification Exams (FTCE). The examinations include FTCE-General Knowledge Exam (GKE), FTCE-Professional Education Exam (PEd) and FTCE-Subject Area Examinations (SAE). The General Knowledge Exam (GKE) must be passed prior to entering the program or within the first semester and the PED and SAE must be passed during your last semester of coursework, but before student teaching

Program Admission- Students must meet minimum criteria for formal admission into program which include completion of Education Common prerequisites 2.5 grade point average and FTCE: General Knowledge Exam. Students need to initiate program admission and should see their academic advisor.

Student teaching internship - All courses must be completed prior the start of student teaching and both the FTCE: Professional Exam and FTCE: Subject Area Exam must be taken, passed, and official scores received by FIU three weeks prior to student teaching.

Students must be fully admitted to their program in order to apply for student teaching. Student may apply for student teaching in the Office of Field Experiences in ZEB 130. Student teaching is a full-time commitment at a public school setting offered in Fall/Spring semesters only.

Electronic Portfolio Requirement- All students enrolled in the Education courses are required to maintain a web based electronic portfolio. Information will be provided in your coursework
