Those who meet the University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU—Two Global Learning Discipline Specific Courses (One of the two may be a Global Learning Foundation Course chosen in consultation with your advisor) Those who do not meet

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the University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU- One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum)- One Global Learning Discipline-Specific Course Transfer courses may not be used to meet the FIU Global Learning Requirement.
