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General Requirements

This major requires no prerequisites. FLENT/FLEX Foreign Language requirement should be satisfied prior to transferring. All Florida College System students are encouraged to complete the Associates in Arts degree before transferring.



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Transfer students are assumed to have completed an Associates of Arts Degree from a Florida Public Institution or satisfied 60 credits and the University Core Curriculum Requirements.

Global Learning Requirement for Transfers: Transfers entering FIU Fall 2011 or later are required to take two Global Learning courses. Those who meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU, will take Two Global Learning Discipline Specific Courses (One of the two may be a Global Learning Foundation Course chosen in consultation with your advisor). Those who do not meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU, will take One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum) and One Global Learning Discipline Specific. Transfer courses may not be used to meet the FIU Global Learning Requirement. For a list of Global learning courses: http://goglobal.fiu.edu College of Arts, Sciences & Education:Requires 45 credits of upper division course work (Level 300 and 4000 courses). Students must earn a grade of ""C"" or higher in all courses required for the major. A grade of ""C-"" or lower is not acceptable in any required course.
