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major. Earning less than the minimum grade is a trigger for a conversation with advisor.*

GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

Transfer students are assumed to have completed an Associate of Arts Degree from a Florida Public Institution or satisfied completed 60 credits and the University Core Curriculum Requirements.

In addition, the following courses are required of incoming transfer students:

Global Learning Requirement for Transfers: Transfers entering FIU Fall 2011 or later are required to take two Global Learning Courses.

Those who meet the University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-Two Global Learning Discipline Specific Courses (One of the two may be a Global Learning Foundation Course chosen in consultation with your advisor)

Those who do not meet the University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

- One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum)

- One Global Learning Discipline-Specific Course

2 Year Plan assumes student has completed an Associate of Arts degree from a Florida Public Institution as well as the SIPA foreign language.

Foreign Language Requirement: Students must demonstrate competency in a foreign language or in American Sign Language at the level of the second semester of a college language sequence. You may be able to satisfy this requirement with AP, CLEP Exam, or other credit. Contact your advisor.

Grades: Students must earn a grade of "C" or higher in all courses required for the major. A grade of "C-" or lower is not acceptable in any required course.

Steven J. Green School of International and Public Affairs: Selected International Relations Requirements

Students must take at least one class from each of the following categories for Group 1:

A. International Law/International Organizations

B. Foreign Policy/Security Studies

C. International Political Economy

D. And a fourth coming from the following:

- An Additional INR-prefixed Group 1 Course

- Comparative Politics

- Economics

- Geography

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- History
- Sociology & Anthropology

Students must take a least one class from each of the following areas for Group II:

- A. Area Studies
- B. Issues and Problems in International Relations
- C. Second AS or IP course
- D. One course from among the following:
 - Geography Courses
 - Religious Studies Courses
 - Economics Courses
 - Anthropology or Sociology Courses
 - Comparative Politics Courses

Students are required to complete both theory courses (INR 4013 and INR 4603) in Group 3. INR 4013 requires successful completion of INR 2001 and three 3000 or 4000 level INR-prefix courses before students may enroll in the course. INR 4603 requires successful completion of INR 4013 before students may enroll in the course.
