College of Communication, Architecture + the Arts: Architecture Specific Requirements

Architecture Admission Criteria: Undergraduate students may apply for admission into the first year or the third year of the program. Applicants must meet the University's admission requirements and submit a design portfolio to the Communication, Architecture + the Arts (PCA 272). The portfolio application deadline is February 1. Summer B Admits: Students admitted to the Accelerated Master of Architecture (AccM.Arc) program for the Summer B term must first meet with an Academic Advisor from Undergraduate Education (PC 249) for course selection for Summer B. During the Summer B term, please schedule a follow-up appointment to meet with an Academic Advisor in the Communication, Architecture + the Arts (CARTA) Student Services and Advising Center to discuss the requirements for this degree program.

The accelerated Master of Architecture path begins freshman year with two years of pre-graduate coursework 73 credit hours, students in good standing move directly to 102 credit hours of graduate coursework. A Bachelor degree is not awarded at any point in the program.
