#### Pre-requisite

Those who do not meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum)

-One Global Learning Discipline Specific Course

Foreign Language Requirement: Students must demonstrate competency in a foreign language or in American Sign Language at the level of the second semester of a college language sequence. You may be able to satisfy this requirement with AP, CLEP Exam, or other credit. Contact your advisor.

Grades: Students must earn a grade of "C" or higher in all courses required for the major. A grade of "C-" or lower is not acceptable in any required course.

Steven J. Green School of International and Public Affairs: Asian Studies Selected Requirements

-Students must complete 9 credits in ASN-prefix course and 9 in Asia-related courses

-Students must also complete 12 credits in a main concentration, 3 credits of supervised research, and 3 credits of required coursework.

-Four semesters of one Asian Language and two semesters of another Asian language are required
