After passing this exam, they must apply for Program Admission with their assigned advisor located in ZEB 210. ### General Requirements

**Prerequisite Courses:**

Students should have completed the Foreign Language Competency requirement prior to transferring to the

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university.

There is a minimum GPA of 2.50 required for the program. This requirement includes Lower Division coursework and Education Common prerequisites.

Students should complete the following Education Common prerequisite courses (Courses, Description, Units):

EDF1005, Intro To Education- 3 credits

EDF2085, Teaching Diverse Pop-3 credits

EME2040, Intro Ed Tech -3 credits

\*An additional 6 credits of International Focus are required. Please refer to your assigned advisor.

\*Major Common Prerequisites - please refer to your Panther Degree Audit and assigned advisor.

\*Critical Indicator is the minimum grade indicated in specific courses to demonstrate proficiency and progress in the major. Earning less than the minimum grade is an alert for a conversation with assigned advisor.\*

### GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

Transfer students are assumed to have completed an Associates of Arts Degree from a Florida Public Institution or completed 60 credits, including the University Core Curriculum Requirements and program prerequisites.

In addition, the following courses are required of incoming transfer students:

Global Learning Requirement for Transfers: Transfers entering FIU Fall 2011 or later are required to take two Global Learning courses.

Those who meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-Two Global Learning Discipline Specific Courses (One of the two may be a Global Learning Foundation Course chosen in consultation with your assigned advisor)

Those who do not meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum)

-One Global Learning Discipline Specific Course

### Education Requirements / Initial Teacher Preparation Programs (ITEP)

FER - FIELD EXPERIENCE REQUIRED additional hours outside of class time - Contact the Office of Clinical Experiences (ZEB 130 / 348-2082) after registration for FINGERPRINT clearance information and school site selection.

TESTING - ITEP programs require completion of the Florida Teacher Certification Exams (FTCE). The examinations include FTCE-General Knowledge Test (GK), FTCE-Professional Education Exam (PEd) and FTCE-Subject Area Examinations (SAE). The GK must be passed prior to entering the program or within the first semester; the PEd must be passed before earning 90 credits; and the SAE must be passed during your last semester of coursework, but before Student Teaching.

ITEP ADMISSION - Students must meet minimum criteria for entry into ITEP programs which include completion of Education Common prerequisites, International Diversity, Major Common prerequisites, 2.5 grade point

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average and FTCE-GK. Students need to initiate ITEP admission and should seek advisement early on through the Advising Center (ZEB 210 / 348-2978).

STUDENT TEACHING INTERNSHIP - the capstone experience for all ITEP programs occurs during a student's last semester (Fall or Spring only). This is a full-time/day-time unpaid commitment at a public school setting. All courses must be completed and entire FTCE passed prior to the start of student teaching. Students must apply for student teaching in the Office of Clinical Experiences (ZEB 130 (305) 348-2082). Applications are due by February 1st for the fall semester and June 1st for the spring semester student teaching.

TASKSTREAM REQUIREMENT - All students enrolled in the Education courses are required to subscribe and maintain a TaskStream account. TaskStream is a web-based electronic portfolio application that allows students to upload and share selected work electronically.

### Elementary Education Specific Requirements

1. TSL & RED methods coursework need to be completed in sequential order as outlined.
2. Content coursework other than RED and TSL may be completed in any order.
