Critical Indicator is the minimum grade indicated in specific courses to demonstrate proficiency and progress in major. Earning less than the minimum grade is a trigger for a conversation with advisor.

TASKSTREAM REQUIREMENT - All students enrolled in the Education courses are required to subscribe and maintain a TaskStream account. TaskStream is a web-based electronic portfolio application that allows students to upload and share selected work via the world wide web.

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(8) Postsecondary Civic Literacy (CL): Students must demonstrate understanding of American Civics via completed course work or test credit. Consult with an advisor to determine the best option for satisfying this requirement.
