*GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

Transfer students are assumed to have completed an Associates of Arts Degree from a Florida Public Institution or satisfied completed 60 credits and the University Core Curriculum Requirements. In addition, the following courses are required of incoming transfer students: Global Learning Requirement for Transfers: Transfers entering FIU Fall 2011 or later are required to take two Global Learning Courses. Those who meet the University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU—Two Global Learning Discipline Specific Courses (One of the two may be a Global Learning Foundation Course chosen in consultation with your advisor) Those who do not meet

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the University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU- One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum)- One Global Learning Discipline-Specific Course Transfer courses may not be used to meet the FIU Global Learning Requirement.
