<p>Fall Term 2021</p> <p>Transfer students are assumed to have completed an Associate of Arts Degree from a Florida Public Institution or completed 60 credits including the University Core Curriculum and the prerequisites requirements. Student must achieve a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA in all of the following required prerequisites: ECO 2023, ACG 2021, ACG 3301, CGS 2060, STA 2122 or STA 3111 or STA 3145 or STA 2023.</p> <p>As of spring 2019, students applying to the program will be granted FULL ADMISSION when the following 5 prerequisite courses have been completed as part of their 60 credit-hours of lower-division course work. A 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA is required for admission.</p> <p>Transfer students applying to the program will be granted CONDITIONAL ADMISSION when 2 out of the 5 prerequisite courses have been completed as part of their 60 credit-hours of lower-division course work. Students will have one academic year (3 semesters) to complete the remaining prerequisites. Additionally, a 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA is required for admission.</p> <p>For conditional admission, please work with academic advisor to better discuss academic map.</p> <p>The BHSA program offers 50% of courses fully online every semester, while the other 50% is on-ground.</p>				<p>Term Hours: 15 Cum GPA: 2</p>

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In addition, the following courses are required of incoming transfer students:

-One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum)

-One Global Learning Discipline Specific Course
