As of Spring 2019, students applying to the program will be granted FULL ADMISSION when all program prerequisite courses, and all University Core Curriculum requirements have been completed as part of their 60 credit-hours of lower-division course work with a minimum "C" grade or higher. Additionally, a 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA is required.

Student must achieve a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA in all of the following required prerequisites: ECO 2023, ACG 2021, ACG 3301, CGS 2060, STA 2122 or STA 3111 or STA 3145 or STA 2023.

The BHSA program offers 100% of courses fully online every semester.

#### BHSA Scholastic Requirements:

To remain in good academic standing, students must: achieve a grade of C or higher in Health Services Administration courses. A student who earns less than a C in any upper division course will be required to repeat the course in order to progress in the program.

#### GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

(1) UCC: Students must meet the University Core Curriculum (UCC) requirements. For a full list of UCC courses, see <http://undergrad.fiu.edu/advising/curriculum.html> or speak with your advisor. UCC courses must be taken for a letter grade and may not be taken at other institutions without permission from the Dean of Undergraduate Education.

(2) Global Learning: Freshmen entering FIU Summer B 2010 or later must take at least two Global Learning (GL) designated courses at FIU. See <http://goglobal.fiu.edu>. Courses must be:

- 1 GL foundation course (from the University Core Curriculum), which must be taken within the first 60 credits.
- 1 GL discipline-specific course (3000/4000 level)

(3) Summer Hours Requirement: All students entering FIU or any university within the State University System (SUS) of Florida with fewer than 60 credit hours are required to earn at least nine credit hours prior to graduation by attending one or more summer terms at a university in the SUS.

(4) Gordon Rule: All Gordon Rule courses (i.e., English Composition, Humanities with Writing, and Quantitative Reasoning) must be completed with a minimum grade of "C." This requirement must be fulfilled within the first 60 credits.

(5) Foreign Language Requirement for Graduation (FLENT/FLEX): A student who did not complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or at a post-secondary institution must successfully complete 8-10 credit hours of instruction in one foreign language prior to graduation. Exceptions include appropriate CLEP, AP, IB, TOEFL, or transfer credit. Contact your advisor for more information.

(8) Postsecondary Civic Literacy (CL): Students must demonstrate understanding of American Civics via completed course work or test credit. Consult with an advisor to determine the best option for satisfying this requirement.

College of Nursing and Health Sciences: Selected BHSA Requirements

\*Cumulative GPA of 2.5 required to be admitted to the program.

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\*The following prerequisite courses must be completed with a minimum grade of a "C": ECO 2023 Principles of Microeconomics, ACG 2021 Accounting for Decisions or ACG 3024 Accounting for Managers and Investors, CGS 2060 Introduction to Microcomputers, STA 3145 or STA 2023 Statistics for the Health Professions or Statistics for Business and Economics

\*A cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required for graduation.
