General Requirements

Critical Indicator is the minimum grade indicated in specific courses to demonstrate proficiency and progress in the major. Earning less than the minimum grade is a trigger for a conversation with an advisor.

GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

Transfer students must have completed an Associate of Arts degree from a Florida public college/university or have completed 60 credits and satisfied the University Core Curriculum (UCC) requirements.

Transfer students transferring from an out of state college/university or a private FL institution, must also satisfy the Civic Literacy requirement. CIV 2222 can be taken in order to satisfy the requirement (<https://testing.fiu.edu/exams-offered/civic-literacy-requirement/index.html>).

In addition, the following courses are required of incoming transfer students:

Global Learning Requirement for Transfers: Transfer students with an Associate of Arts degree are required to take two discipline specific Global Learning (GL) courses which are part of the Generic BSN program of study. These GL courses include NUR 3666, NUR 3821, and NUR 4667.

Transfer courses may not be used to meet the FIU Global Learning Requirement. For a list of Global Learning courses visit: goglobal.fiu.edu.

Generic BSN Program Requirements:

The Nursing-BSN is a limited access program, and admission is highly competitive. The average admitted student cumulative GPA is much higher than the minimum requirement.

-FIU UCC or AA degree must be complete by the end of the spring semester in order to be an eligible applicant for the upcoming fall term.

-A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 is required from all previous coursework, including dual enrollment.

-Successful completion of the ATI TEAS exam with a minimum overall score of 70% and a minimum 62% in the science portion.

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- Completion of all nursing prerequisites by the end of the spring term within the corresponding application cycle.
- NO FAILURES (C- or below) are allowed in the required science prerequisites, even if the courses have been successfully repeated for a passing grade. Science courses must have been taken within the last ten years.
- The application cycle runs from December 15th to March 15th.

Scholastic Requirements for Generic BSN Program Admits

To remain in good academic standing students must:

1. Achieve a grade of 'C' or higher in nursing courses. A student who earns less than a 'C' in any nursing course will be required to repeat the course in order to progress in the nursing program. A student may repeat a course one time only. Students who have failed two nursing courses or have two failures in the same nursing course will be dismissed from the program.
2. Pass required examinations: Generic students are required to take specific nursing achievement examinations (to be announced at the beginning of each academic term). In addition, generic students are required to pass a nursing synthesis (exit) exam as a prerequisite to the BSN degree. This examination is given during the last semester of the program.
