This also applies to NC grades for the science prerequisites and labs. The student would then be required to change their major.

General Requirements

Critical Indicator is the minimum grade indicated in specific courses to demonstrate proficiency and progress in major. Earning less than the minimum grade is a trigger for a conversation with advisor.

GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

(1) UCC: Students must meet the University Core Curriculum (UCC) requirements. For a full list of UCC courses, see <http://undergrad.fiu.edu/advising/university-core-curriculum.html> or speak with your advisor. Students requesting to be transient must receive permission from their academic advisor/department.

(2) Global Learning: Freshmen entering FIU Summer B 2010 or later must take at least two Global Learning (GL) designated courses at FIU. See <http://goglobal.fiu.edu>. Courses must be:

- 1 GL foundation course, which must be taken from the University Core Curriculum (UCC).
- 1 GL discipline-specific course (3000/4000 level).

(3) Summer Hours Requirement: All students entering FIU or any university within the State University System (SUS) of Florida with fewer than 60 credit hours are required to earn at least nine credit hours prior to graduation by attending one or more summer terms at a university in the SUS.

(4) Gordon Rule: All Gordon Rule courses (i.e., UCC Communication, UCC Mathematics, and Gordon Rule with Writing (GRW) courses) must be completed with a minimum grade of "C." This requirement must be fulfilled within the first 60 credits. Students are required to complete at least two Gordon Rule with Writing (GRW) designated courses.

(5) Foreign Language Requirement for Graduation (FLENT/FLEX): A student who did not complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or at a post-secondary institution must successfully complete two terms of the same language at the introductory level OR one term of an intermediate advanced level course prior to graduation. Exceptions include appropriate CLEP, AP, IB, TOEFL, or transfer credit. Contact your advisor for

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more information.

(6) UCC Mathematics: Math courses are categorized into either Group One or Group Two. One math course from each group is required, unless the first math taken is from Group Two and has an immediate prerequisite in Group One. In this case, students will take two Math courses from Group Two. However, one of the two Math courses must have a MAC, MGF, or MTG prefix.

(7) Postsecondary Civic Literacy (CL): Students must demonstrate understanding of American Civics via completed course work or test credit. Consult with an advisor to determine the best option for satisfying this requirement.

Generic BSN Program Requirements

The Nursing-BSN is a limited access program and admission is competitive. The average admitted student's cumulative GPA is much higher than the minimum requirement.

- FIU UCC or AA degree must be complete by the end of the spring semester in order to be an eligible applicant for the upcoming fall term.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 is required from all previous coursework, including dual enrollment.
- Successful completion of the ATI TEAS exam with a minimum overall score of 70% and a minimum 62% in the science portion.
- Completion of all nursing prerequisites by the end of the spring term within the corresponding application cycle.
- NO FAILURES (C- or below) are allowed in the required science prerequisites, even if the courses have been successfully repeated for a passing grade. Science courses must have been taken within the last ten years.
- The application cycle runs from December 15th to March 15th.

Students MUST see advisor if minimum 3.25 cumulative GPA is not met or a grade below C in any science prerequisite is obtained. Students should consider changing major if minimum GPA not met, however students MUST change their major if a grade below a C is received in any science prerequisite, including labs. This also applies to NC grades for the science prerequisites and labs.
