GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

-Two Global Learning Discipline Specific Courses (One of the two may be a Global Learning Foundation Course chosen in consultation with your advisor)

Those who do not meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum)

-One Global Learning Discipline Specific Course

College of Nursing and Health Sciences:

(1) RN TO BSN PROGRAM SCHOLASTIC REQUIREMENTS:

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To remain in good academic standing, students must achieve a grade of 'C' or higher in required nursing courses. A student who earns less than a 'C' in any required nursing course must repeat the course in order to progress in the nursing program. A student may repeat a course one time only. Students who have failed (C- or lower) two required nursing courses or have two failures in the same nursing course will be dismissed from the program.

(2) GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS:

Transfer students are assumed to have completed an Associates of Arts Degree from a Florida Public Institution or completed 60 credits and the University Core Curriculum Requirements.

In addition, the following courses are required of incoming transfer students:
