Must be admitted to the NWCNHS Accelerated Option BSN Track for the Fall B Session to use this major map. See cnhs.fiu.edu/academics/nursing for admission requirements and application deadlines. Please note that this track is now available for foreign educated physicians seeking a BSN.

Students must also satisfy the civic literacy requirement if transferring from an out of state school or from a private Florida institution. All previous Florida college or university graduates are exempt from this requirement. Requirement should be satisfied during the fall B term by taking CIV 2222 (<https://testing.fiu.edu/exams-offered/civic-literacy-requirement/index.html>). See advisor.

The courses below will be during the Fall B Session (an 8-week mini session offered in the second half of the fall term). Students will apply for admission to the university for Fall semester, in order to enroll in these courses. Previous FIU students need to apply through Undergraduate Admissions as second bachelor's degree students.

Please be aware that financial aid is not available during this session since only 5 credits are required, and a minimum of 6 credits are needed to receive financial aid.

GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

Admitted students to this program are assumed to have completed a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university, therefore satisfying the University Core Curriculum (UCC) requirements. In

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addition, these students will receive an automatic waiver of the university's Global Learning (GL) requirement. See waiver policy here: <http://goglobal.fiu.edu/Courses/Pages/Waiver-Policy.aspx>.

Accelerated Option BSN requirements:

The Accelerated Option BSN is a limited access program and admission is competitive. To qualify for this program students must have previously earned a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution with a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA at the completion of the degree, and must have a minimum cumulative 3.25 GPA in all required nursing prerequisites.

Students must also satisfy the civic literacy requirement if transferring from an out of state school or from a private Florida institution. All previous Florida college or university graduates are exempt from this requirement. Requirement should be satisfied during the fall B term by taking CIV 2222 (<https://testing.fiu.edu/exams-offered/civic-literacy-requirement/index.html>).

Foreign educated physicians seeking a BSN are now eligible to apply for this track. Students cannot have already received an RN license! A course by course evaluation of the foreign medical degree must be completed by a NACES accredited company, and an equivalent Doctor of Medicine must be awarded. The minimum GPA requirement is a 2.00 from the medical degree. These students may also have to take the TOEFL exam if they are from a non-English speaking country. Proof of U.S. permanent residency or U.S. citizenship is also required for eligibility.

Scholastic requirements for students admitted to the Accelerated Option BSN Track:

To remain in good academic standing students must:

1. Achieve a grade of 'C' or higher in required nursing courses. A student who earns less than a 'C' in any nursing course will be required to repeat the course in order to progress in the nursing program. A student may repeat a course one time only! Students who have failed two nursing courses or have two failures in the same nursing course, will be dismissed from the program.
2. Pass required examinations: Accelerated Option BSN students are required to take specific nursing achievement examinations (to be announced at the beginning of each academic term). In addition, Accelerated Option BSN students are required to pass a nursing synthesis (exit) exam as a prerequisite to receiving the BSN degree. This examination is given during the last semester of the program.
