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General Requirements

Prerequisites:

Should have Steven J. Green School of International and Public Affairs Foreign Language requirement satisfied prior to transferring.

This major requires no prerequisites. All Florida College System students are encouraged to complete the Associates in Arts degree before transferring.

Critical Indicator is the minimum grade indicated in specific courses to demonstrate proficiency and progress in major. Earning less than the minimum grade is a trigger for a conversation with advisor.

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GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

Transfer students are assumed to have completed an Associates of Arts Degree from a Florida Public Institution or satisfied completed 60 credits and the University Core Curriculum Requirements.

In addition, the following courses are required of incoming transfer students:

Global Learning Requirement for Transfers: Transfers entering FIU Fall 2011 or later are required to take two Global Learning courses.

Those who meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-Two Global Learning Discipline Specific Courses (One of the two may be a Global Learning Foundation Course chosen in consultation with your advisor)

Those who do not meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum)

-One Global Learning Discipline Specific Course

Steven J. Green School of International and Public Affairs: Selected Requirements

Foreign Language Requirement: Students must demonstrate competency in a foreign language or in American Sign Language at the level of the second semester of a college language sequence. You may be able to satisfy this requirement with AP, CLEP Exam, or other credit. Contact your advisor.

Grades: Students must earn a grade of "C" or higher in all courses required for the major. A grade of "D" or lower is not acceptable in any required course.

-Courses must be taken to satisfy the following areas:

-Religious Area (12 credits): One course in each of the following areas:

-Abrahamic Religions

-Asian Religions

-Indigenous Religions

-Society, Culture, and Ethics

-Focus Courses (18 credits): Twelve or more credits in Religious Studies and up to six credits in related studies. Related studies include: Art History, English, History, Humanities, International Relations, Philosophy, Psychology, Sociology/Anthropology, or other appropriate departments.
