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### General Requirements

Prerequisites: Should have Steven J. Green School of International and Public Affairs Foreign Language requirement satisfied prior to transferring.

Common Prerequisites: SPN 1130, SPN 1131, SPN 2200, and SPN 2201 (Non Heritage Learners) or SPN 2340 (Heritage Learners); or a student can demonstrate proficiency in the language at an intermediate level through testing by the department.

\*Critical Progress is the minimum grade indicated in specific courses to demonstrate proficiency and progress in major. Earning less than the minimum grade is a trigger for a conversation with advisor.\*

#### GENERAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

Transfer students are assumed to have completed an Associates of Arts Degree from a Florida Public Institution or satisfied completed 60 credits and the University Core Curriculum Requirements.

In addition, the following courses are required of incoming transfer students:

Global Learning Requirement for Transfers: Transfers entering FIU Fall 2011 or later are required to take two Global Learning courses.

Those who meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-Two Global Learning Discipline Specific Courses (One of the two may be a Global Learning Foundation Course chosen in consultation with your advisor)

Those who do not meet University Core Curriculum Requirements prior to entering FIU

-One Global Learning Foundation Course (from the University Core Curriculum)

-One Global Learning Discipline Specific Course

**Foreign Language Requirement:** Students must demonstrate competency in a foreign language or in American Sign Language at the level of the second semester of a college language sequence. You may be able to satisfy this requirement with AP, IB, CLEP Exam, or Other Credit. Review possibilities with your advisor.

**Grades:** Students must earn a grade of "C" or higher in all courses required for the major. A grade of "D" or lower is not acceptable in any required course. Students are required to earn 48 Credits of 3000-4000 Level Courses, keep track of total by reviewing your Panther Degree Audit, and meet with your advisor for ideas on possible Minors/Certificates that would help you reach your goal.
